RULES & REGULATIONS

The Raft

The raft can be built out of any material and in any way, but must comply with the following regulations:

- The raft must have a secure towing point.
- No boats, skis or canoes will be permitted to enter.
- No rafts with rudder, keel, skegs, guiding strips, "v" shaped hull or pointed bow. No streamlining of the hull below the waterline (apart from a front bevel) designed or intended to gain advantage over the other rafts.
- Only one, single bladed paddle per person will be permitted – no power-driven rafts will be permitted.
- The raft must be able to complete the whole course and teams must be able to lift the raft and move it at least 50m.
- All rafts must be available to be examined before the race and at any other time as requested by the judges. Only legal rafts may qualify to receive a prize.
- All objections of non-complaint rafts must be lodged prior to the start of the race.

The Team

- All teams must appoint a team captain, who will be responsible for the team's safety on the raft.
- Each team will have to complete a course of approximately 500m and the tasks at the check points along the route.
- No more than 4 people shall be allowed per raft.
- Only the registered team members may be allowed to paddle or push the raft.
- No children under the age of 16 will be permitted without the parents or guardians' consent and signature on the application form.

Safety

- All participants enter at their own risk.
- Any commercial/industrial containers must be thoroughly washed before entering the water.
- Buoyancy aids or lifejackets must be on the raft at all times.
- Dangerous objects may not be taken on board any raft or thrown or propelled at other rafts.
- NO GLASS BOTTLES will be allowed on the raft.
- Participants are not permitted to throw empty cans or other garbage into the dam, nor abandon rafts or parts of the rafts.
- The organisers are not responsible for recovery of rafts and team members who fail to complete the course.
- Rafterers are requested to move their rafts away from the check and landing points as soon as possible to make way for the other rafts behind them.

Other

- Entry fees must be paid in full by **20 January 2022** at the Winter Festival office or via EFT.
- Registration will take place from 07:30 to 09:00 at the main gate.
- Raft inspection will take place between 09:00 and 11:00 with the race starting promptly at 12:00.
- Prizes will be awarded for the best dressed team, the best team spirit, and overall winners.
